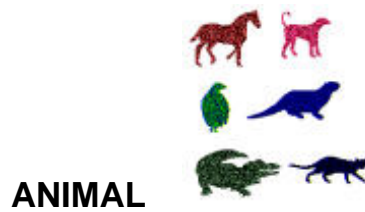

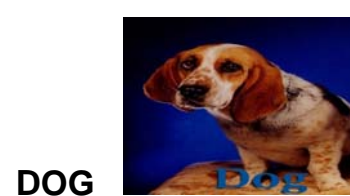

**TO READ / READ (rid) (rédi)**

You need to read this.

He doesn't like to read.



**TO HELP / HELPED**

Do you want to help me? Please, we need to help her!

**TO KNOW / KNEW** - (nô)saber, conhecer

I don't know you. Do you know Spanish?



**TO GIVE / GAVE** (guêv) (geiv)

I want to give this **to** you. He wants to give money.
